Read the following article carefully, and then in your ANSWER BOOKLET answer all the questions that follow. Your answers should be based on the article.

The first paper was made nearly two thousand years ago in China. Although paper can be made from many kinds of materials, such as cotton fibres, grass or sugar cane, these days wood pulp is the material most commonly used to make 'new paper'.

The modern world uses so much paper that environmentalists have persuaded us that we should recycle old paper as well as making new paper. Paper can only be recycled four or five times. There is an increasing awareness in Jordan of the need to recycle both paper and other materials. Paper-recycling containers can now be found in some parts of the country and some government agencies have begun paper recycling programmes. Also, there is greater education in schools about the need to take care of our environment.

Although we use wood pulp from trees to make new paper, it is not true that recycling paper saves trees. Trees are a commercially grown long-term crop, so that when they are cut down, new ones are planted. Also, papermakers use the parts of trees that cannot be used in other industries such as building and furniture making. Nearly all new paper is made from wood grown in sustainable forests.

Recycling paper is less harmful to the environment than burying it in landfill sites. In the interests of our environment, we have to make sure that we continue to recycle as much of it as possible.
